General Description:

Temporary, seasonal. CDL required. This position performs semi-skilled construction and maintenance tasks that support the operational functions of the Nacogdoches County Road & Bridge Department. Duties include the use of a wide variety of construction and maintenance equipment, including operating dump trucks, water trucks, haul trucks, loaders, mixers, mowers and other light equipment. Also performs a variety of other maintenance duties such as repairing potholes, shoulder and edge-work paving, trimming trees and brush and packing and watering roads.

- Operates various light equipment including boom axes, bat wings, brush hogs, fork lifts, chain saws and grid rollers
- Performs manual road construction, repair and maintenance tasks
- Picks-up and delivers equipment to and from construction sites
- Installs street barricades and cones prior to the performance of street repair activities, directs and controls traffic around work sites
- Builds and install road signs, fences and barricades
- · Cuts trees, picks-up and disposes of debris, garbage and dead animals
- Cleans and inspects culverts and assists with the construction of county bridges
- Performs preventive maintenance on equipment as required, change and replenish fluids
- Inspects equipment for proper functioning and safety
- · Assists other departmental staff as required
- Performs additional duties as assigned or needed

Work Environment:

- Work will be performed outdoors
- Exposure to extreme temperatures
- Exposure to noise, dirt, dust and vehicle exhaust
- Working in and/or near water including creeks and ditches
- Exposure to fumes and smoke, electrical hazards
- Working in confined or high work places, and on slippery and/or uneven surfaces
- Exposure to hazards associated with traffic control and working in and near traffic

Requirements:

- Must pass a pre-employment physical (to be arranged by Nacogdoches County)
- Ability to work outside in extreme heat for up to 10 hours per day
- Ability to lift and carry heavy materials and equipment in excess of 50 lbs
- Ability to sit, stoop, bend, crouch, crawl and reach
- Ability to climb and work from ladders and construction related equipment
- Ability to stand and walk for extended periods of time
- Ability to report to work as scheduled and on-time
- Valid Texas CDL
