<i>Approving the ad valorem tax rate of \$1.2008 per \$100 valuation in Martinsville Independent School District for the current year, a rate that is \$0.13 higher per \$100 valuation than the school district rollback tax rate, for the purpose of maximizing state funding. If approved, the tax rate of \$1.2008 will allow the District to shift tax effort from I&S, for the payment of principal and interest on bonds, to maintenance and operations, and will still be lower than the 2016-2017 tax rate of \$1.2618.</i>
