

FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS DEFERRED DISPOSITION INSTRUCTIONS:

READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY - Failure to do so may void your request.

Code of Criminal Procedure Article 45.051 Suspension of Sentence and Deferral of Final Disposition

- 1) The defendant must enter a plea of no contest or guilty and make a request to the Court for Deferred Disposition.
- 2) The request must be made by the appear date on the ticket.
- 3) If you are under 25 years of age and request Deferred Disposition, you will be required to attend a Driver's Safety Course per State Law.
- 4) You are NOT eligible for Deferred Disposition if you hold a CDL (Commercial Driver's License)
- 5) There will be a special expense fee in addition to State court costs.
- 6) The Court may order a disposition deferred up to 90 days.
- 7.) When all requirements are met the defendant may be granted a Deferred Disposition after the deferral period ends.

___ I understand that failure to complete any requirements imposed by the Court will result in a final conviction on my record.
